What is it? It's Critical Mass! CM is not an organisation, it's an unorganised coincidence. It happens when a lot of cyclists happen to be in the same place at the same time & decide to cycle the same way together for a while.

What's the cause? CM is a celebration of the alternatives to cars, pollution, accidents & the loss of public spaces and freedoms. CM lets people reclaim their cities with their bikes, just by getting together & out-numbering the cars on the road.

What happens on a Critical Mass? Each ride is different & follows no set route, with the direction being spontaneously chosen as the people cycle. Anyone is free to join or leave the ride as it pedals along. The ride lasts no more than a couple of hours (depending on the weather!) & is peaceful, safe and fun.

Do I need a bike? No. CM is not just for bikes. Skateboards, rollerblades, wheelchairs, pogo-sticks... In fact any form of non-motorised, non-polluting vehicle is welcome.
