## **Key measures for easing the daily lives of the Palestinian Population: Main points**

• Below please find the comprehensive plan for improving the Palestinian population's fabric of life:

Steps to empower Abu-Mazen

Encouraging the private sector.

**Employment of Palestinians in Israel** 

Entry of foreign nationals into the West Bank.

Facilitate movement regime.

Easing the passage of Palestinians through checkpoints and removing obstacles.

Easing the movement of **International organization** staff in the territories.





Coordination with the P.A chairman's office and those subordinated to him, the Palestinian Passages Authorities, the Water Commissioner, and the Presidential institutions.

Approving entry of donations (security equipment) for the Presidential Guard by expedited procedure.

## Strengthening Abu-Mazen

Easing the movement of VIP's and senior Palestinians, facilitating movement without security checks.

#### **Strengthening of the Private Sector:**

Movement of businessmen with BMC documentation provides:

Easing of the security checks at Erez Crossing and Allenby bridge, permitting overnight stay in Israel and access to Ben Gurion airport (upon individual request).

Possible return of \$60 Million from the frozen tax money to the private sector, subject to identification of the businessman, and the formation of a working mechanism.

Merchants quota from Gaza to Israel was increased



# Upholding the policy of employment of Palestinians from the W.B. in Israel.



**Increasing** the number of Palestinians working in the **agricultural sector**, **2,000** of whom are permitted overnight stay in Israel.

#### Entry of Foreign Nationals from Countries that Maintain <u>Diplomatic Relations with Israel into the West Bank – Procedures</u>



#### **Entry into the West Bank:**

In general, entry of foreign nationals from countries maintaining diplomatic relations with Israel into the West Bank is possible.

Entry of the aforementioned foreign nationals will be permitted through means of the military commander's consent, on the basis of which an entry permit from the Ministry of Interior will be granted.

Nationals from countries that do not have visa agreements with Israel can enter the West Bank through Israel, after receiving a visa from the Ministry of Interior, through the embassy/consulate at their country of origin. The request must detail the reason for the visit.

Nationals from countries that have visa agreements with Israel may enter the West Bank by either one of the following procedures:

- Preliminary coordination through the embassy /consulate at the country of origin (recommended).
- Uncoordinated arrival at the border. This necessitates some checking procedures at the border crossing.



#### In general, nationals will be able to receive an entry visa valid for three months.



#### The following groups are eligible:

- Spouses of local residents.
- •Representatives of international organizations.
- Businessmen/ investors/ persons with working permits.
- Pilgrims.
- Reporters.
- Volunteers, lecturers, consultants and others.

#### Visa Renewal:

The visas can be extended by sending a request to the representative of the Ministry of Interior in Beit- El, in either of the following ways:

- Approaching the Palestinian population registry representative in Ramallah and applying for a visa renewal.
- In exceptional cases independently approaching the Israeli Ministry of Interior representative at Beit El.



#### The following groups will be able to extend the visa for another year



(total staying time shall not exceed 27 months):

- Spouses of local residents.
- Businessmen.
- Investors.
- People with working permits (bankers/ doctors).

At the end of the 27 months, a further extension may be granted (provided the foreign national exits and re-enters the area).

International organization employees can obtain a six month renewal for their visa in either of the following ways:

- Sending a request to the International Relations Branch at the Coordinator of Government Activities in the Territories.
- Sending a request to the Israeli Ministry of Interior population registry regional offices for employees that live within Israel.

#### Comment:

The "LAST PERMIT" stamp has been cancelled. People who have this stamp on their passport may leave the area, and their return will not be prevented solely on the basis of the stamp.





Supervised movement of unique populations between the areas is possible.

Improvement of movement for unique populations (businessmen, medical staff and international organization employees) not defined by COS order.

## **Movement Regime**

The entering of Arab-Israelis into the cities of Kalkilya, Tulkarem, Bethlehem and Jericho is possible.

#### Karni crossing:

Continuity of the crossing is maintained.

Easing conditions of exporting merchandise (flowers and agricultural produce).

Conveyer belts for aggregates and cement.

A crane for the transportation of containers has been installed.

The option of expanding the activity hours of the crossing till 23:00 is being considered.

Establishing of infrastructure to improve the crossings operation.

## **Crossing Points**

Rafah Crossing: open for entery and exit of the Haj pilgrims from Egypt. Easing of the transportation system through the back to back platforms in the W.B. – Replacing from containers to palettes, lowering the security checks to random checks.

Movement of agricultural merchandise from the Jordan valley to Israel is possible (back to back).

Movement of stone products to Israel through Jab'a crossing is possible (Bethlehem).
